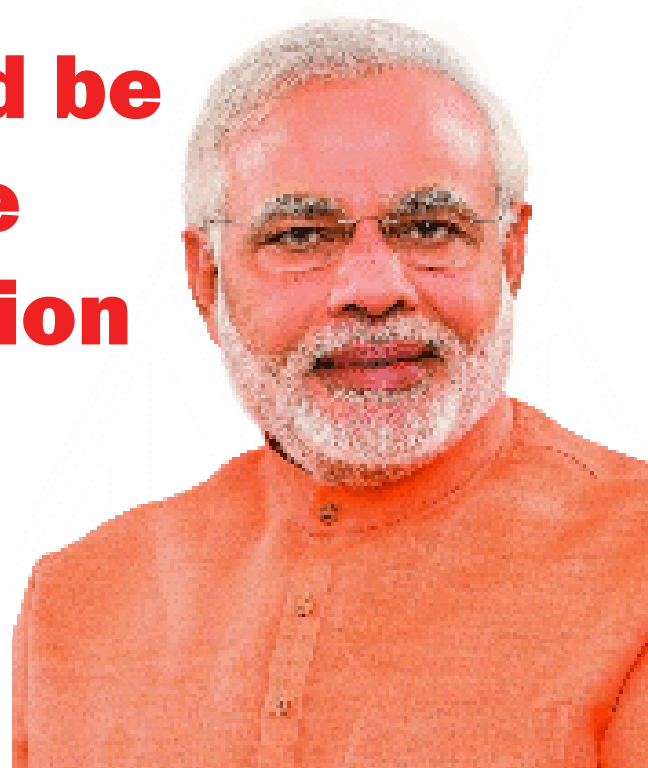




Who Should be the Face of Opposition in 2024

Next year, the general elections to the Lok Sabha in 2024 will be held. The BJP knows that it remains in power because of breaking the back of leaders of opposition, not on the strength of good governance. The BJP has completed all its work except Hindu Rashtra. Now it doesn't even have any work. The BJP also knows that if its government continues, there is no need to create a separate Hindu Rashtra. When the party has no work, businessmen like Gautam Adani are misusing the party in their own way. Due to this, the credibility of the

BJP is getting worse day by day.

There is an old saying that what leads to success also causes the downfall. In 2014, it was people like Adani who brought the Bharatiya Janata Party to power with the power of their money. Now due to these people, the BJP may also be ousted from power. In the 2024 elections, the Party has nothing to say. The only thing to say is that there is no alternative to Narendra Modi, the PM. Apart from listing the weaknesses of the opposition, the BJP will not have any agenda in the 2024 elections. If the opposition finds a face whose shield can never be penetrated by any weapon of the BJP, then the BJP will be burdened with its anti-people works will go into the abyss in the 2024 elections. The BJP has no leadership other than Modi. But the opposition has the full sky of freedom for choosing the leadership.

So much heavy waste of anti-incumbency has been collected on the boat of the BJP. The Boat of the Party is set to sink in the 2024 elections. I don't agree with the assessment of those who think that the Bharatiya Janata Party's boat will sink on its own in 2029. My assessment is that the BJP's boat of power will sink in 2024 itself. There is a need for the opposition to work with national spirit, free from personal political ambitions, and make sincere efforts to remove the BJP instead of wrestling with the BJP.

How should be the leadership of the opposition?

But the big question is how to know that those who are working against the BJP, their efforts are an honest effort? Their unity is for the economic advancement and cultural security of the people of the nation? Is their desire to gain power to make India a powerful

nation and bring India to historic honour on the international stage? How can it be known that after gaining power, the bunch of people who have ousted the BJP will not fight among themselves and will not pave the way for the BJP to come to power again? How do you know that their efforts are free from personal political ambitions? How will it be known that their leadership is wearing a shield that no weapon of the BJP can penetrate?

In this article, we will embark on a journey exploring these questions. We will also take all the people who are reading this article, including you, with us in this journey. Before embarking on this quest to find sources of opposition unity and success, we will carry the items what we will need in this search journey. First of all, the leadership that the opposition adopts should not have any connection with the BJP and the RSS far and wide. The opposition leadership should be left-wing rather than right-wing like the BJP. It should advocate a mixed economy rather than a capitalist economy and polity. The leadership of the opposition should be such that it does not advocate the communist system in reaction to capitalism. Instead of making the rich persons more rich like the BJP is doing, the leadership of the opposition should be a leader who gives economic strength to the common people. Instead of advocating the religious rights of one community in

the name of secularism, it should protect the religious rights of all communities along with their duties. He should be a personality rising above nepotism, casteism and sectarianism. The opposition leadership should have a clear road map to take India on a journey of 21st century. That is, he should have a proper understanding of international politics and world economy. That is, the leadership of the opposition should be opposed to the path on which the BJP follows.

India is a very large nation in Mr. Vishwatma and an emerging world power. So the leadership of the opposition should have knowledge of English language. He should not need a teleprompter like Narendra Modi needs to speak English. Whatever qualities the BJP leadership has, the leadership of the opposition must have all those qualities. If there are more qualities, it will be even better. The BJP leadership makes people understand that a person having its own family members cannot be free from corruption. Therefore, the person leading the opposition should be someone who is free from family life. It would be better if he is not married. In the case of renunciation austerity, the position of the opposition leadership should be higher than that of the BJP leadership. The leadership of the opposition should be such that its art of speech delivery and its impact should be bigger than the leadership of the BJP. The

effect of giving a speech is only when the person is a big scholar, studious and also a good writer. The leadership of the opposition should not be someone who is burdened with the junk of anti-incumbency. Therefore, the opposition should drive an all India search campaign like Samudra Manthan and hand over its leadership to someone who is a completely new face. He should be free from the burden of anti-incumbency arisen due to power. This can happen only if that person has never been in power.

No matter how much Hindutva the BJP calls for, its identity in society is that of the party of upper caste Hindus. Since the upper caste vote bank has gone with the BJP, the opposition should keep an eye on the OBC and SC-ST vote bank. This can happen only if the leadership of the opposition comes from these communities. No matter how qualified and honest the upper caste leadership may be, as long as removing the BJP from power is a priority, the upper caste leadership is a big threat to the opposition. The warriors of the upper caste society who are struggling against the BJP can be in the role of king makers. OBC and SC-ST society should also accept this role of justice loving upper castes.

It is not enough to lead the opposition that he or she belongs to the SC-ST-OBC community. Right now it is also necessary that he/she is fearless and not afraid of going to jail. Therefore, it is nec-

essary that the leadership of the opposition has the experience of being in jail. Otherwise, he will be intimidated by the ED and the CBI even before opposition unity gains. He will work for the BJP inside the screen before and after the elections. This betrayal of the public will be done so closely that no one will even know.

In the coming days, the BJP will be contested only by a person who is free from political ambitions, free from the lust to acquire political positions and wealth, and also free from the temptation to pursue a son and daughter. He must have an insight and have full confidence in that insight, So that he can lead a diverse country like India for a long time, coordinate the conflicting communities present inside India and play the role of a judge between conflicting political and cultural ideologies.

The objective of the opposition leadership should not be limited to removing the BJP from power, but it should have the ability to lead India for a long time. That is why his age should not be more than 65 under any circumstances. However, many heads of state in Mr. Vishwatma have worked till the age of 85. But still, after the age of 75, the efficiency of a person decreases to a great extent. She should not be so young as to fall in love with a beautiful woman, a powerful man and become a victim of the BJP's honey trap in the country or abroad.

The BJP should not get any opportunity to attack the opposition leadership, so it is necessary that the leadership of the opposition should not be anti-Hindu and should not have any criminal history. The leadership of the opposition should be such that Muslims like to support it. But he should not be a Muslim or a who is pro-Muslim and is accused of working under the pressure of irrational demands of Muslim politicians and appeasing them.

Overview of the face qualities of the opposition

The list of qualities expected for opposition leadership given above, Now let's look at him with a cursory eye. The leadership of

the opposition should be left-wing, advocate of mixed economy, secular and anti-sectarianism. He should be anti-nepotism, anti-racist, equipped with international master plans, at least Hindi and an influential speaker of the English language. He should be unmarried, free from the burden of junk of anti-incumbency acquired due to being in power, he should belong to OBC or SC/ST community. He should be an experienced person of jail visits. He should be free from political ambitions, free from the ambition of wealth and property, free from the infatuation of his offshoots. He should have the insights that can coordinate the conflicting



parties, be under 65 years of age, mature in sexual matters, have no criminal history. He may be a Hindu lover, but he must oppose the irrational and unconstitutional things of Hindus. He may be a Muslim lover, but free from Muslim prejudice.

There are many more parameters that can be added to this list. But if all the qualities mentioned in this article are also seen under the leadership of the opposition, then no move by the BJP can stop the opposition unity from being maintained. It cannot stop the opposition from reaching power in the 2024 elections. The BJP cannot stop the opposition from staying in power for a long time after coming to power with so many qualities. After seeing so many qualities in the opposition leadership, a large part of the BJP's support base will start supporting the opposition.

Evaluation of claimants

Now, as the leader of the opposition, we evaluate the people whose names are being already raised in India. Among those who are staked their claim to lead the opposition in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections are Congress' tallest leader Rahul Gandhi, west Bengal's current Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, Telangana Chief Minister KC Rao, and a big leader from Maharashtra, Shri Sharad Pawar. To evaluate all these claimants we will use the 20 scales counted above.

Evaluation of Nitish Kumar



First of all, we will evaluate former Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar. He is seen as a big face in the kind of face the opposition wants. The positive side with his name is that he is not from the upper caste society. He belongs to the OBC community. But according to the qualities set for the 2024 election, when we test Nitish Kumar, he fails the test. The reason is that he have been long-time friends of BJP and RSS. So now he is neither counted in the category of left leader nor in the category of secular leader.

Nitish Kumar is a duly married and a family man. It is the general nature of such people to suffer from infatuation to offshoot and to run their whole life around the longing for wealth and political posts. Therefore, he cannot become an anti-nepotism face. He is a leader born from the background of caste politics. So forget about international master planning, he don't even have any national planning and road map.

He delivers makeshift speeches in Hindi language, but is not a speaker of English language. Due to being in power for a long time, he is burdened with the junk of anti-incumbency. He belongs to the OBC community, but while living with the Bharatiya Janata Party, he has lost his faith in the OBC and SC/ST society. He is accompanied only by a few politicians of his caste, who work to transfer the votes of the people of his caste only in Bihar. Their own caste support base is also not with them in whole country.

Nitish Kumar has never been accused of any kind of immoral and illegal sexual activity. There is no account in the public domain of how much criminal conspiracy he may have committed against his political opponents to stay in power. It is natural for this to happen, because he continued to be in power.

But that doesn't mean he is completely free from the criminal image. Nitish Kumar is the same crime-free person as the Narendra Modi is. His secular image has been destroyed while he was with the BJP. But the positive side is that he is now considered an ally of The Hindutva leaders. This positive aspect makes him anti-Muslim. When his position in the BJP started weakening and he felt that he would not be able to become the Chief Minister by winning the election, he compro-

mised with Lalu Prasad Yadav and contested the election and became the Chief Minister. He told the BJP lies to become the Chief Minister. He described the BJP as anti-Muslim, anti-secular, anti-poor, anti-farmer, anti-worker and anti-Constitution. After becoming chief minister, Lalu Prasad Yadav was turned around. He again became an ally of the BJP. When he felt that the opposition was looking for someone for the prime minister, he again left the BJP and was listing the same shortcomings in the BJP, which he had pointed out to become the Chief Minister by joining Lalu ji.

Seeing Nitish Kumar's theory, opportunism, treacherous nature, many people believe that he is working on the diplomatic agenda of the Bharatiya Janata Party. He has left the BJP on the diplomatic instructions of the BJP. After the 2024 elections, if THE BJP gets a majority, Nitish Kumar ji will be the happiest. Because the next election of the Chief Minister will be won again with the help of BJP. Even if the opposition is strong and fights the 2024 elections unitedly under his leadership, he would prefer to form a government at the Centre with the BJP or continue to be the chief minister instead of forming a lame government with opposition parties. Given this strong possibility, the opposition will not consider him as their face. If the opposition does not consider him as their face, then in the political

greed, he will work to break the opposition unity inside and pave the way for the Bharatiya Janata Party to return to power in 2024.

Evaluation of Mamta Banerjee



Mamata Banerjee considers herself at the forefront of the race for the post of Prime Minister in 2024. Her assessment is that the opposition will consider her as their leader. There are many reasons behind this. Her biggest positive point is that she has defeated Narendra Modi in the West Bengal elections. She is considered to be a completely secular personality. She is unmarried. Therefore, Narendra Modi is considered a strong candidate to compete with her character. She has never been accused of nepotism, infatuation and greed for wealth. She is not a leftist, but he is definitely an advocate of mixed economy. She may not be able to speak Hindi well, but speaks well in English and Bengali. He was never accused of

In this way, in terms of leading the opposition, he gets 5 marks out of 20.

character degradation. She's not afraid of prison. So she is fearless. If Modi is a snake, Mamata Banerjee is a mangoosh. Her age is also appropriate to become prime minister.

Along with these positive sides there are also some negative sides to her name. Mamata Banerjee has no international vision. What she has achieved in her political career, she has not achieved on the basis of any national or international insights. Rather, it is because of its risk-taking calibre. Due to being in power for a long time, the high burden of junk of anti-incumbency is also on her shoulders. She is considered a politician with an extreme political ambition. Even if she has to jump into the quagmire of criminal conspiracy to fulfill her political ambition, she has never shied away from it. In West Bengal, her image is that of loving Hindus, but in the rest of the country, her image is undue favouring of Muslims.

Incidentally, one of her negatives is that she comes from the upper caste fraternity. Now this fraternity is considered to be the strength of the Bharatiya Janata Party. Had she belonged to the OBC or SC/ST community,

she would have had a lot of convenience in becoming the face of the opposition. After reaching the constitutional post, her caste fraternity and upper caste people will occupy power. This apprehension of opposition leaders from non-upper castes will prevent her from becoming the face of the opposition. Making Mamata Banerjee the face will embarrass opposition leaders who have been calling for unity of OBC and SC/ST communities and who have been advocating participation of these communities in power and property.

Mamata Banerjee is an aggressive leader. People consider her a dictator. This nature brings her very close to Narendra Modi. There is a big fear of opposition leaders that one dictator may be replaced by another dictator and the opposition may be caught in the terror of another dictator. Just as Narendra Modi has kept his party leaders powerless, Mamata Banerjee also never allows her party leaders to grow in West Bengal. Many opposition leaders are already afraid that after making Mamata Banerjee the Prime Minister, the campaign to remove her will have to be run in the same way as it has to be run to remove Narendra Modi today. If this situation arises, Mamata Banerjee's opponents will have to join the Bharatiya Janata Party again in the future. Looking at all these grounds, Mamata Banerjee gets 10 marks out of a total of 20.



Telangana CM K C Rao's Assessment

Telangana's Chief Minister K Chandrasekhara Rao's political career is much longer than his age. Based on this length, Rao is presenting his claim to become PM of India in 2024. His appeal to the opposition is that he should be considered as the face for the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. Elections should be fought under his leadership and after winning the election, he should be made the Prime Minister. Let's also test them on the criteria required for leadership.

K Chandrasekhara Rao is a leftist by ideas and also a supporter of a mixed economy. He is secular. Like Mamata Banerjee, he has been in power for a long time due to his risk-taking and his hyper-political activism. He has got the credit for creating Telangana state. That is why he is the hero of his state's politics. He is a duly married and infatuated man. K. Chandrasekhara Rao has been accused of nepotism. He is very closely related to acquiring wealth

and political ambitions. In this sense, he is not able to compete with Narendra Modi. He speaks Telugu, Hindi and English but is not a very effective and convincing speaker. Like Mamata Banerjee, he too has no national and international planning and road map. Due to being in power for a long time, the burden of junk of anti-incumbency is also imposed on them. K Chandrasekhara Rao is an appropriate person looking his age. But he has no insight to maintain harmony in a country of conflicting communities like India.

But the biggest thing that goes against him is that like Mamata Banerjee, he too comes from the upper caste community. It will not be easy for leaders belonging to backward and Dalit communities to consider an upper caste person as their leader and contribute their share in making him the Prime Minister. This type of Chandrasekhara Rao gets a total of 6 marks out of 20.

Evaluation of Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal



simplicity campaign has proved to be a hoax. He don't have any national and international planning and road map. He is married and has children. So naturally he is infatuated with. In this case, he is not able to compete with Narendra Modi. He is one of the most notorious politician in terms of political ambition. Arvind Kejriwal is very fond of wealth. Like other parties, Kejriwal also has a habit of sending rich people to the Rajya Sabha. He knows Hindi and English well but he has never been an effective and influential speaker. Like Mamata Banerjee and K Chandrasekhar Rao, his biggest weakness is that he comes from the upper caste society. If opposition leaders from backward classes, Scheduled Castes and Tribes consider Kejriwal as their leader, then they will not be able to show their face in their own society. Therefore, obc, SC, ST community leaders would not want Arvind Kejriwal to be the face of opposition in 2024.

Kejriwal leaves no stone unturned to woo Muslims. Muslims also gave full support to Kejriwal. But dalits and Muslims of the country understood late that if Kejriwal had not launched a movement against Congress, this party would still been in power. Had the Congress been in power, the country would not have caught the mess of dictatorship of Narendra Modi. Therefore, the person who has the sin of bringing Narendra Modi to power is Arvind Kejriwal.

Arvind Kejriwal's name is also among those who have put their necks forward to wear the Prime Minister's crown. Arvind Kejriwal claims that only he can stop Narendra Modi. He have done it inside the city of Delhi. Whatever happens from the inside, he tells people from outside that he does not work on any theory, any ideology. Rather, he work to give small relief to the people. He is also giving relief like schools, electricity, water in Delhi.

Arvind Kejriwal wants to create an opportunity for himself to change his ideology by seeing the opportunity. Therefore, neither he can be called leftists nor rightists. If he see benefits for himself, he can also be leftists and if he see losses from the Left, they can also leave the Left and run away. If he looks benefit from socialism, he can become socialists and if he see his own benefit in capitalism, he can become supporter of capitalists. Political selfishness

and opportunism are their biggest political ideologies. If he gets a chair, he can also be a Muslim supporter and if there is a loss in giving justice to Muslims, then he can also be a activist of Hinduism. If he has the ease of getting a chair, he can also be racist and if casteism creates inconvenience in getting the chair, then he can also be anti-caste. Arvind Kejriwal can prove to be the most suitable person in terms of age. He was never accused of immoral and illegal sex. Like Nitish Kumar, Mamata Banerjee and K Chandrasekhar Rao, Arvind Kejriwal too does not have any national and international criminal.

Arvind Kejriwal was a fresh face when Narendra Modi became prime minister in 2014 By that time, he was not burdened with the junk of anti-incumbency waste. But after 8 years, he is now burdened with the huge burden of junk of anti-incumbency waste. His anti-corruption and political

Kejriwal lost his faith even by not creating Jan Lokpal in his own state of Delhi. This incident proved that Kejriwal is not opposed to corruption. He started the anti-corruption movement as his rhetorical tactics only so that he could get power. A major allegation against him is that he took money from those people of America and Canada to get power, who wanted assurance of making Punjab a separate country in the name of Khalistan. Kejriwal is also facing serious allegations that he took money from the then corrupt billionaires just to save them from arrest and jail of the 2G spectrum scam in 2010, who owned mobile companies and were accused in the 2G spectrum scam. Kejriwal is accused of taking money and promising to overthrow the Congress government, so that these billionaires could be protected from arrest jail and punishment in the 2G spectrum scam. He is also accused of conspiring against the country in collaboration with the famous US agency Ford Foundation to overthrow the Congress.

What happens to all the ruling Chief Ministers is that the public is not aware of their conspiracy and their crimes. Due to being in power, the neck of mainstream media remains in their hands. Therefore, the general public only gets to hear good news about them. Looking at all these facts, Kejriwal gets only 3 marks out of a total of 20

Assessment of Rahul Gandhi



The Congress has been officially making statements that it will not field any candidate for the post of Prime Minister in the 2024 elections. Congress says that it will support the name of the opposition, on whose name the opposition agrees. But this is rhetoric statement only. If the opposition agrees to Rahul Gandhi's name, then Rahul Gandhi would definitely like to become the Prime Minister in 2024. Therefore, it is necessary to evaluate Rahul Gandhi's name as the election face of 2024.

It is well known that like Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru and Indira Gandhi, Rahul Gandhi is also a left-leaning person. He has shown no interest in communism and has been a fiercest critic of privatisation and capitalism. This shows that he is in favor of a mixed economy. Congress has been accused of nepotism. He decided that he would stay away from marriage and not settle down. Like his family, he too believes in secularism and is trying

to become neither a Hindu nor a Muslim. He Hindi and speaks well in English. Some time ago, his speech was not considered effective, but in the last few years he has developed this ability to a great extent. It is difficult to say about Rahul Gandhi whether he likes to go to jail or not because he never went to jail. But it would not be wrong to conclude that he wants to escape from jail.

Rahul Gandhi does not appear to be as personally obsessed with political ambitions as Nitish Kumar, Mamata Banerjee, Chandrasekhar Rao and Arvind Kejriwal. People like Nitish Kumar, Mamata Banerjee and K Chandrasekhar Rao are lobbying to become prime minister in 2024 but not Rahul Gandhi. There is no attempt by Rahul Gandhi to acquire property. If there was any such attempt, the BJP would have exposed it in its 9-year tenure.

Rahul Gandhi is now 54 years old. Therefore, in terms of age, he is perfectly suited to become the Prime Minister. There is no

news that he has committed any crime or committed a criminal conspiracy in his life. The case of National Herald is known to all. This case has been going on for a long time. But the government could not produce any evidence against him to show that he had committed any economic crime for personal gains.

Rahul Gandhi is not a casteist personally, but it cannot be said that people around him will not use power for the benefit of the upper castes, like Mamata Banerjee and Arvind Kejriwal. The biggest issue against him is that Rahul Gandhi was born in the upper caste family. Therefore, it will be very difficult for leaders working on the mission of giving share in power and property to SC/ST OBCs to accept Rahul Gandhi as prime minister. If leaders of these sections accept Rahul Gandhi as the Prime Minister, they will find it difficult to answer in their society.

Unlike Jawaharlal Nehru, Rahul Gandhi does not have any insight to present and implement any national and international vision. In this case, Rahul Gandhi is the same category leader as Nitish Kumar, Mamata Banerjee, Arvind Kejriwal and K. Chandrasekhar Rao. No case of immoral and illegal sexual relations has come to light against Rahul Gandhi. The BJP has presented him as anti-Hindu. But this blame is more on their ancestors, less on him. The BJP has also accused Rahul Gandhi of being pro-Muslim. But he was never

in power. Therefore, even though his ancestors have been accused of Muslim appeasement, Rahul Gandhi is free from this charge.

Rahul Gandhi could not be accused of oppression and atrocities while in power. Because he has never been in power. Rahul Gandhi may have been free from the burden of junk of anti-incumbency waste, but his party has not been free. The biggest weight of junk of anti-incumbency is on his party. From this point of view, the Congress party is the shackles of his feet. Rahul Gandhi does not show the courage to break these shackles and leave the Congress. Keeping all these facts in mind, Rahul Gandhi gets 14 out of 20 points if evaluated.

Is there no alternative to Modi in the country?

In the current circumstances, the first criteria were identified which are required to become the leader of the opposition in 2024. After this, Nitish Kumar, Mamata Banerjee, K. Chandrasekhar Rao, Arvind Kejriwal and Rahul Gandhi were evaluated on those parameters. Rahul Gandhi got the highest number of marks. But he also did not get 100% marks. They could get 14 out of 20 marks. Mamata Banerjee was at number two. She got 10 out of 20 marks. Telangana Chief Minister K. Chandrasekhar Rao got 6 out of 20 marks. Nitish Kumar was at number four. He could get only 5 marks out of 20. Arvind Kejriwal was at number five by getting only 3 out of 20 marks. In per-

centage terms, Rahul Gandhi got 70%, Mamata Banerjee got 50%, K. Chandrasekhar Rao got 30%, Nitish Kumar got 25% Arvind Kejriwal got 15% marks.

If we evaluate other Chief Ministers of the country as well, there is no possibility that any person will get 100% marks. Former Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Akhilesh Yadav, current Chief Minister of Orissa Naveen Patnaik, current Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Sh. Jagan M Reddy, current Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu Stalin, current Chief Minister of Kerala Pinarayi Vijayan and an influential politician of Maharashtra Sh. Sharad Pawad are not among the contenders for the Prime Minister's post in 2024. But if he is evaluated, he cannot get better marks than Nitish Kumar.

In such a situation, the work of finding the face of the opposition in 2024 is not possible only among the well-known faces of the country. In this sense, there is a lot of truth in the fact that there is no alternative to Narendra Modi at present. It would be appropriate to say this only if those people in the country who are not currently the Chief Ministers of any state and their names do not even appear in the list of former Chief Ministers. That is, we have to evaluate the country's lawyers, journalists, professors, officials, litterateurs, farmer leaders, labor leaders, etc. One of them may come out to be 100% or around the qualification set to stand up to Narendra Modi.

Evaluation of Vishwatma as the face of opposition in 2024



When Google was used to do my research, the name of a new person came out. This is the name of the Mr. Vishwatma. The literal meaning of Vishwatma is global soul. He is an social and political activist and author by profession. He has written several dozen books on the reform of the polity and the economy. He believes that the system of governance that is going on in the country is not able to solve the problems of the present and future generations. Therefore, the entire emphasis of the Mr. Vishwatma is on system change. The Vishwatma does not merely raise slogans of system change, but he has a formal blueprint of the new system.

One of the reforms proposed by him is such a reform, which is very popular in the general public. Between 2005 and 2008, 137 MPs presented his proposal in both houses of Parliament. In 2008, there was a debate in Par-

liament on this subject. But the main leaders of the big political parties of the country stopped it. The matter was forwarded to the Standing Committee. The Standing Committee constituted an expert committee. The Expert Committee unanimously accepted this revolutionary reform of Mr. Vishwatma on December 02, 2011. Even after the committee was accepted, the government put the recommendations of the committee on the back burner. This proposal of reform is still on the back burner. When the prominent leaders of all the major parties remained silent on this proposal of reform, Mr. Vishwatma announced the formation of a new party in 2012. This party was named - Voters Party International. The party was registered with the Election Commission of India in 2016. However, no candidate of this party has been able to win elections in any state till 2022. But the support base of this par-

ty is continuously increasing. His party has a large support base in the north eastern states of India. But main stream media, due to its policies, refrains from publicizing the news of this party. Therefore, the people of the country do not know about this party.

The work done by Mr. Vishwatma in the public and among the MPs put pressure on the government. Due to this pressure, the government had to enact the MGNREGA law in 2005. It was under the pressure of Mr Vishwatma that the laws related to Aadhaar card were enacted in 2008. Under this law, aadhaar card was given to all the people in the country. A new tradition of sending the subsidy of gas cylinders directly to the people's account started with the help of an Aadhaar card. Due to the pressure created by the work of Shri Vishwatma, the Food Security Act had to be enacted in 2010. Under this law, free food grains are being given to people all over the country today. The work done by the Manmohan Singh government under the pressure of Mr. Vishwatma, there was a reaction in the industrial houses. In 2011, the reactionary forces sponsored the Anna movement with their own funds and the Manmohan Singh government lost power. The result of this movement was that Arvind Kejriwal became the Chief Minister of Delhi in 2013 and Narendra Modi became the Prime Minister of India in 2014. The political success that these

two got is due to the mobilisation of hundreds of MPs by Mr. Vishwatma.

When Narendra Modi became prime minister in 2014, despite pressure from industrial houses, he too carried forward the work of Mr. Vishwatma like the Congress. Under pressure from Vishwatma's work, Narendra Modi had to order the opening of Jan Dhan accounts in 2015. Parliament had to pass a resolution for "Universal Basic Income". By planning the Kisan Samman Nidhi, farmers had to pay Rs. 500 every month. All the cash transfer schemes had to be implemented by the governments of all the states. In this sense, after 2005, India's politics has revolved around Mr. Vishwatma.

But it is surprising that most of the people of the country have no knowledge about Mr. Vishwatma and their deeds. All these information were seen when the author was looking for suitable leaders of India on the Internet? Keywords like "The Best Party of India", "The Best Leader of India", "The Best Politician in India" were all searched on Google. Then all the videos and information appeared on the screen. One of them was a video with the thumbnail written - "Party ho to aisi" in Hindi. After watching this video, it seemed that the person speaking in the video thinks differently and is committed to improving the dirty politics of India. The curiosity that this video generated led to this curiosity to explore more about Mr. Vishwat-

ma. In this process of searching, it was found that Mr. Vishwatma also has its own YouTube channel on which more than 400 videos are uploaded. Many of his websites appeared on the Internet. These websites contain a lot of information about Mr. Vishwatma, about his life story, about his works, about his books, about his party and about his charitable trust "Mission for Global Change, MGC" working for political reform.

The content available on the internet about Vishwatma forced me to search for him and meet him personally. I felt that I had got a glimpse of the kind of leadership the country is looking for. But without meeting him, our investigative journalism was not ready to be satisfied. So we got his phone number and address from the internet and reached Delhi to meet him. They had to catch a flight to Assam, so our meeting did not last very long. But the longer I spoke, I got convinced that this man had the potential we are looking for. After the search was over, my satisfaction was encouraged me to write this article. Because the well-known faces mentioned in this article above are generally known to the people. So there was no need to write about them in more detail. But if I do not write in detail about my discovery, Shri Vishwatma, the purpose of this article is not fulfilled. If I have searched for a person as the face of the opposition, it is also my responsibility to tell about the grounds of my search.

After meeting Mr Vishwatma, I brought some books written by him. From these books, we came to know that Vishwatma has a detailed plan to establish prosperity and peace not only for the country but also for every person in the whole world. We also came to know that the person's commitment to ideals did not allow the man to desired resources. It was his principled nature that did not allow Vishwatma's party to win any election so far. In today's election system, Mr. Vishwatma is against to adopt those tactics to win elections which are generally used by winning politicians. He wants to achieve good goals, but not by unfair means. He has an amazing patience inside him. He believes that "real medicine catches the market one day, even if caught late".

Mr Vishwatma has family ties with Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh. After meeting him, it was found that he spends most of his time in Delhi, Lucknow, Guwahati and Mumbai. He ended his educational life at the age of 22. It is not worth believing that at such a young age, a person quits his studies only because if he did an administrative job by taking competitive exams, he would have snatched the job of someone else. At the age of 27, he decided not to get married until he provided employment or a source of income to all people. He also decided that he would not open any bank account until all the people of the country

opened their bank account and their income started. In 2023, he is 53 years old. He still doesn't have a bank account.

If you evaluate Mr. Vishwatma as the face of the opposition in 2024, many surprising results come out. A study of his videos, his books and his works on YouTube shows that he is a left-leaning person. He is not a supporter of both capitalism and communism economies. Rather, he has found a middle path between the two. It would also not be appropriate to call this middle path a mixed economy. This is an economy based entirely on the Vishwatma's original thinking, which the Parliament of India has studied but other agencies are yet to study.

He believes that the objectives of secularism are right. But he says that the word secular does not express its own purpose properly. Therefore, he advocates the use of the word "seccommunism" means communism amongst sects instead of secularism. He himself is unmarried. He does not own any movable and immovable property. His personal expenses are based on donations made by supporters of his ideology. Any member of his family are not included in his party and his trust. That is, Mr. Vishwatma is completely far from infatuation and nepotism. He is against the casteism to such an extent that he changed his name at the age of 50, with no word indicative. He belongs to the Yadav caste of the

Other Backward Classes.

The paradox of his personality is that on the one hand he has universal thinking and believes in global humanism. On the other hand, he is struggling to get SC-ST and OBC communities a share in the power and wealth of India and the whole world in proportion to their population. He is an influential speaker of Hindi and English. Sometimes lakhs of people gather to listen to them.

Vishwatma has been jailed twice till the age of 53. In 2001, when the Uttar Pradesh government tried to take away the employment and houses of the spinning mill workers of Meerut, Vishwatma protested and had to go to jail under the National Security Act. He made his second jail trip in 2020 under a high level political conspiracy when the entire country was locked inside its homes in the lockdown. He considers jail visit as necessary for every social worker and politicians. He believes that whoever makes honest efforts to reform the current system will have to go to jail not once but many times. If someone does not go to jail, it means that he or she wants to enjoy power by taking advantage of the status quo instead of making any kind of reform.

When the whole country was misguided by the joint action of Arvind Kejriwal and Anna Hazare during 2011 to 2014. Mr. Vishwatma was working to restrain the parliamentary approval of Jan Lokpal Bill, which was according

to Mr Vishwatma completely anti-constitutional and corruption accelerating. Mr Vishwatma was the first person who presented a bill for constituting Lokpal. He appeared before the standing committee and exposed the Anna Movement. Consequently the Jan Lokpal bill was finally rejected in spite of all efforts made by the biggest newspapers and mainstream TV Channels. Mr. Vishwatma presented a representation before government of India to conduct a CBI enquiry and find out those names who were funding for media coverage violating all the rules, regulations and norms of journalism. The CBI is still not deployed by the government.

Mr. Vishwatma has its own fundamental views on godly power and over the sovereignty of the state. Vishwaatma solves the question of conflict of faiths in a new way. His search is such that even people of conflicting ideologies are satisfied with them. In his party, the Left also works and so do the right wing persons. Capitalists work and communists work too. Believers work as well as atheists. Those advocating for the rights of the villages also work and those who intend to form a world government also work. In his party, workers of all religions and all castes are able to work smoothly. If their discoveries are understood and included in the education system and included in political science books, most of India's community conflicts

will be ended, says Mr. Vishwatma. Mr. Vishwatma has an special machanism to bring all the people and patties together having deferent type of interests and ideology. It is his inherent nature also.

Mr. Vishwatma is a believer. He says that he not only believes in the power of God, but also knows the power of God very well. He claims to know the science of faiths. Vishwatma loves all religions including Hindus and Muslims. He even loves atheists as much as believers. He is against to the irrational things of all religions. He never had any connection with the Bharatiya Janata Party or with the RSS. This is the first qualification to become the face of the opposition against Narendra Modi in 2024. On this scale, Mr. Vishwatma is best person. Narendra Modi's personality does not stand anywhere in front of him in terms of sacrifice and penance. He is very popular among the poor, farmers, labourers, Scheduled Castes, Tribes and Backward Classes. Because no one else has the same plan as the scheme presented in the Parliament of India for the upliftment of these sections. One family, fed up with poverty, consumed poison and died. When he saw this incident in the newspapers, he was so sad at the age of 29 that he did not eat food for 14 days. His hunger stopped after the intervention of the then Prime Minister, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee.

Mr. Vishwatma is the head of

a political party, but he has never been an MLA, MP or minister. He has fielded hundreds of candidates from his party. But he himself has never contested an election in his life. Winning elections has never been his priority. The priority of life of Mr. Vishwatma is to give the share in economic prosperity to the general population, rooting out conditions that create community violence, and establishing permanent peace within the country and around the world. He prepared the blueprint of the kind of polity and economy needed to fulfill this purpose. It was presented in dozens of books. Constitution approval of these political and economic reforms has been the basic objective of all his political activities. Merely winning elections has never been his objective. People say - "Do not dance, the courtyard crooked". Vishwatma says "How to dance, the courtyard is crooked". He conclude that as long as the courtyard of the polity and economy remains crooked, the majority society will continue to be subjected to economic oppression, riots, violence and wars.

The content that is read about him on the website makes him feel that Vishwatma is not the man of this planet. He deliberately ends his educational career at the age of 22. Because he thought that if he go to administrative jobs, he will take away others' jobs. He started running an organization of MPs at the

age of 35. MPs of almost all parties in this organization were former ministers and former chief ministers. He ran this organization of MPs from 2004 to 2009. Mr. Vishwatma also used to run a study circle of these MPs. The number of MPs participating in his study circle was upwards of 100. Many MPs from this study circle became chief ministers of many states of India. Many of them became cabinet ministers in state governments and in the Government of India. But Vishwatma never took direct or indirect advantage of such high political relations. He never even showed interest in taking photos with such big personalities.

Vishwatma's nature shows that he is a person of saintly attitude. But if he saw injustice in front of his eyes. So he never like to tolerate. He can go far in the matter of punishing the wrongdoer as per law. He do not shy away from risking even their lives. He do not need a lawyer for litigation in the High Court and the Supreme Court. He writes the petition himself. Appearing in the High Court and the Supreme Court, he argues for himself. He has been attacked several times in Assam, Uttar Pradesh and in Nagaland as part of a political conspiracy. Every time he was safe. However, on the court's order, he had to live under high-level police protection for many years.

Never holding the posts of MP, MLA or Minister is also the biggest negative aspect of Mr.

Vishwatma and this is also the biggest positive aspect. Since Mr. Vishwatma has never held these posts, the intelligence agencies have nothing to say against him. If he is made the face of the opposition in the 2024 elections, then during the elections, there will not be a word to speak against him, let alone the possible allegations from the BJP. Due to not being in any post, there is no burden of any kind of junk of anti-incumbency on him. The allegation of turning away from anything against him is not far away. There has never been any allegation of immoral and illegal sexual relations against Mr. Vishwatma.

Mr. Vishwatma has neither any political ambition, nor the temptation to acquire wealth. He has a good understanding of national and international politics and economy. He has also written several books on these topics. His personality is an open book. All the videos about his personal life are available on YouTube. Hundreds of videos about his social, economic, political and religious thinking are found on the internet. That is, there is nothing hidden about him. Keeping all these facts in mind, if Mr. Vishwatma is evaluated as the face of the opposition in 2024, then he gets 19 out of 20 marks.

My research concludes that if well-known faces in the field of politics are pitted against Narendra Modi ji in 2024, then they are bound to be bombarded with allegations. Because the BJP has

tremendous power of the media. This will benefit the BJP and Narendra Modi. But if the opposition gains power at the Centre by presenting Mr. Vishwatma as the face of opposition, the BJP will not get a word to attack. The opposition's line in the leadership of Mr Vishwatma will be many times bigger than the BJP's line. If there is a change of power on this policy, then the government formed in 2024 will also be stable and there will be no scope for the BJP to reinstate in power in 2029.
